With Module REQUIRED for Sonoma County Ag-Livestock Disaster Pass Training

LANGUAGE: ENGLISH

AUDIENCE: Volunteer Disaster Service Workers, CART volunteers, CERT members, and Community leaders. Commercial Crop and/or Livestock producers and property owners who want to apply for a Sonoma County Department of Agriculture disaster entry document.

This class is also appropriate for anyone who lives, works, or engages in recreation in the Wildland Urban Interface, and anyone who wants to be safer in an emergency.

Crucial subjects covered include identifying hazards, assessing risks, and utilizing tools to recognize potential hazards during emergencies such as wildfires, floods/landslides, earthquakes, and other disasters. In addition, it will address wildfire and structural fire safety, such as avoiding entrapment, understanding fire behavior, general wildfire safety measures, current concerns, and preparing your home for fire safety.

An additional module will include information necessary to complete the "Ag Pass" requirements.

- All attendees completing All Hazards-Wildfire Safety will receive a certificate of completion.
- Attendees completing all modules will receive a Certificate of Completion of the CA Ag-Livestock Disaster Disaster Training.
